Skirts and dresses were usually short, especially in the latter part of the decade; however, loose and flowing dresses as well as long denim skirts were also notable trends.

From the 1920s to the 1990s, popular fashions reflected the mood of each decade and showcased changes in society as the styles of clothing and accessories evolved with the times.
